

NATIONAL ASSESSMENT RESULTS - SUMMER TERM 2014**END OF KEY STAGE ONE**

A Year Two pupil is expected to achieve **Level 2**. The percentages of our Year Two pupils assessed in the summer term 2014 gaining Level 2 and above were as follows:

Some children achieve **Level 3** which is above average. The percentages of our Year Two pupils assessed in the summer term 2014 gaining Level 3 and above were as follows:

A Year Six pupil is expected to achieve **Level 4**. The percentages of our Year Six pupils tested in May 2014 gaining Level 4 and above were as follows:

Writing	100%	85%
Spelling, grammar and punctuation	100%	76%
Mathematics	100%	86%

Some children achieve **Level 5** which is above average. The percentages of our Year Six pupils tested in May 2014 gaining Level 5 and above were as follows:

Reading	95%	50%
Writing	60%	33%
Spelling, grammar and punctuation	90%	42%
Mathematics	90%	52%

Some children achieve **Level 6** which is exceptional. **35%** of our pupils achieved Level 6 in Mathematics (*national 9%*), **15%** in writing (*national not published*), **25%** in Spelling, Grammar and Punctuation (*national 5%*) and **0%** in reading (*national 0%*).
