

**NATIONAL ASSESSMENT RESULTS - SUMMER TERM 2015****END OF KEY STAGE ONE**

A Year Two pupil is expected to achieve **Level 2**. The percentages of our Year Two pupils assessed in the summer term 2015 gaining Level 2 and above were as follows:

Some children achieve **Level 3** which is above average. The percentages of our Year Two pupils assessed in the summer term 2015 gaining Level 3 and were as follows:

**END OF KEY STAGE TWO**

A Year Six pupil is expected to achieve **Level 4**. The percentages of our Year Six pupils tested in May 2015 gaining Level 4 and above were as follows:

	<b>British Section Results</b>	<b>England National Results</b>
<b>Reading</b>	<b>100%</b>	<b>89%</b>
<b>Writing</b>	<b>95%</b>	<b>87%</b>
<b>Spelling, grammar and punctuation</b>	<b>95%</b>	<b>80%</b>
<b>Mathematics</b>	<b>95%</b>	<b>87%</b>

Some children achieve **Level 5** which is above average. The percentages of our Year Six pupils tested in May 2015 gaining Level 5 and above were as follows:

	<b>British Section Results</b>	<b>England National Results</b>
<b>Reading</b>	<b>81%</b>	<b>48%</b>
<b>Writing</b>	<b>71%</b>	<b>36%</b>
<b>Spelling, grammar and punctuation</b>	<b>81%</b>	<b>56%</b>
<b>Mathematics</b>	<b>75%</b>	<b>42%</b>

Some children achieve **Level 6** which is exceptional. **15%** of our pupils achieved Level 6 in Mathematics (*national 9%*), **0%** in writing (*national 2%*), **10%** in Spelling, Grammar and Punctuation (*national 4%*) and **0%** in reading (*national 0%*).
